

## THE BANNED ITEMS LIST

Some novelty items are considered unsuitable for sale. Anything that can be used to create injury or nuisance to animals or people is banned from sale. A list of unsuitable and banned items is available on our website.

The list largely supports the Agricultural Shows Banned Items List.

We have agreed that the following items are banned from sale or display at the Diamond Creek Rotary Town Fair:

- Pop downs (throw downs), 8 Shot Caps, Strip Caps, Roll Caps. All Caps are banned.
- Fireworks - Crackers – Explosive items of any description are banned.
- Knives of any description.
- Toy guns are acceptable; however, the following are not: pellet guns, ball bearing guns, replica guns (bullet type), Potato Guns (Bullet Type). Samurai Swords, English Swords and Fencing Swords are to be sold in sealed Packages by Licensed Traders ONLY.
- Similarly, guns or toys (for sale or given as prizes) that **fire projectiles** or water including bow and arrows or **create noise** which can be a public nuisance or frighten animals, excluding shooting galleries **are banned**.
- Water pistols less than 150 mm in length are permitted. Water bombs are not permitted.
- Explicit & Hardcore T-Shirts, Explicit DVD's & videos, Fake Cigarettes, Fuel Type Fire Lighters (Zippos), Iridescent hair spray, Horns and Trumpets, Metal and Wooden martial art nunchuckers, Playing Cards (Nude or Lewd), Pressure Pack items—Gas (all types), Snow, Silly String, Drug Related Goods (incl. Cocaine Kits and Bongs etc.), Stink Bombs, Laser Pointers, pen lights, Torches etc., Bouncing Beans.
- ANYTHING THAT CAN BE USED TO CREATE INJURY OR NUISANCE TO PEOPLE OR ANIMALS IS BANNED.

**Please Note:** It is the Site holder's responsibility to ensure they are compliant with the laws regarding the sale of Novelty Items, including the Dangerous Goods (Explosives) Regulations 2000, Regulation 803 and the Dangerous Goods Act 1985-554, so that an illegal item is not sold at the Show. Banned or illegal items will be confiscated and the names of the Site holders found selling banned items will be circulated to the police and other fair and ag show organizers.
